

**PART I – THE SCHEDULE
SECTION H
SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS**

H-1 ENHANCED SUBCONTRACTING SMALL BUSINESS REQUIREMENT

a. The contractor shall manage the subcontracting plan in accordance with FAR 52.244-5, 52.219-8, 52.219-9, 52.219-24 and 52.219-25 to ensure 10 % of the total annual contract dollars are subcontracted to small business of any type. “Any type” means small business, small disadvantaged business (SDBs), women-owned small business and HUBZone small business. Total small business subcontracting of 10 % is a requirement. Apportionment of that 10 % among the small business types are goals as set forth in the contractor’s Small Business Subcontracting Plan attached to this contract.

b. The contractor shall report actual achievement of the subcontracting results using the Standard Form (SF) 294 required by 52.219-9. Because the SF 294 is set up to calculate small business subcontracting as a percentage of total subcontracting, the contractor shall include an addendum which shows small business subcontracting as a percentage of the total annual contract dollars. Also, the addendum to the SF 294 shall separately show dollars subcontracted to SDBs under North American Industrial Classification (NAIC) Major Groups determined by the Department of Commerce under the Far 19.12 SDB Participation Program versus dollars subcontracted to SDBs under NAICs not included in that program.
